Naming a future guide dog puppy is a unique way to pay tribute to a member of your family, a dear friend or to commemorate a special occasion, while supporting the work of Guiding Eyes.

The donor and/or honoree will receive:

- A Personalized Naming Certificate
- Updates during the puppy raising period with photos
- Notification of acceptance into formal guide dog training program.

And if the puppy completes the program, we will provide:

- Announcement of placement with a visually impaired student
- Invitation to the graduation ceremony, if applicable
- A graduation photograph of your dog, copy of program and recognition in Graduation slide show.



The guidelines for naming a Guiding Eyes for the Blind puppy are:

- Names that are easy to say. Most two syllable names work well.
- Please don't use inappropriate names such as "Killer" or 2 syllable names like Billy Joe.

Since each litter is assigned names according to a letter of the alphabet there may be a delay in the naming of the puppy.
