## Guiding Eyes for the Blind Board of Directors

Dr. Trivedi is the Director of Glaucoma, Mount Sinai Health System at CareMount Medical Group, based in Mount Kisco, NY. He is a Board certified, fellowship trained specialist in glaucoma and cataract surgery. He has been in private practice with CareMount Medical group since 2007.

He graduated from the Loyola University Chicago Stritch School of Medicine in 2002, where he was selected among the top medical students in the country to join the Alpha Omega Alpha National Medical Honor Society.

Dr. Trivedi then completed his residency at the New York Eye & Ear Infirmary, the oldest eye hospital in the US, in 2006. He spent another year there honing his surgical skills in the subspecialty of glaucoma.

He is currently a Clinical Associate Professor, Department of Ophthalmology, New York Eye & Ear Infirmary of the Mount Sinai Icahn School of Medicine and is a preceptor to medical students from New York Medical College, Valhalla, NY.

Dr. Trivedi has participated in multiple clinical trials and was the first glaucoma surgeon in Westchester to use novel devices such as the Glaukos iStent as well as the Allergan XEN gel implant for the treatment of glaucoma.

Dr. Trivedi has received several awards during his career. He was voted Top Doctor by Westchester Magazine almost every year since 2015, and Top Doctor by New York Magazine among all doctors in the New York Metro area since 2017. He has been selected by his peers for the Castle Connelly Top Doctor Award every year since 2015, and this year was rated among the top 6% of all physicians in the United States.

He is a surgeon volunteer with Operation Restore Vision, part of Operation International, travelling to Uganda to perform sight saving cataract surgeries. He serves on the Board of Directors of Guiding Eyes for the Blind in Yorktown, NY, which trains exceptional guide dogs for visually impaired individuals. He also serves on the Board of Directors for the Ambulatory Surgery of Center of Westchester in Mount Kisco, NY.

He is a Fellow of the American Academy of Ophthalmology, and is a member New York State Ophthalmological Society, the American Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgeons, American Glaucoma Society, and Westchester Academy of Medicine.

Dr. Trivedi resides in Northern Westchester with his wife and three children.
